Reusable Final Post-Press Finishing Sheet
for DTF, DTG, White Toner Transfers, Vinyl/HTV, and more

CONDITION BEFORE FIRST USE

Place the MagicSeal Sheet on the lower platen with the rubbery side facing down.



20 seconds
@ 270°F / 132°C



Medium
pressure

This conditions the sheet for proper performance.

COMPLETE YOUR NORMAL TRANSFER

Press and peel your transfer normally according to the instructions for the transfer film, technology or fabric you are using.



Use MagicSeal Sheet for
the final post-press only.

FINAL MAGICSEAL PRESS

Place the MagicSeal Sheet over the finished design with the rubbery side facing down against the print.

132–143°C

Helps seal and mold the image deeper into the garment fibers for improved wash and stretch durability.

IMPORTANT USE & REPLACEMENT NOTES

MagicSeal Sheet

- Final post-press only
- Do not cut the sheet
- Best life when used near 270°F
- Approx. 300–500 presses
- Wear is easier to see
- Higher temperatures can shorten sheet life

Replace when the coating looks worn, results become less consistent, or after no more than 300–500 presses.



Upgrade to MagicSeal PRO Sheet™

- Recommended for improved softness, durability & premium results
- No conditioning required
- Textured side down
- Use at the same temperature as your first press
- Operating range: 270–330°F
- Approx. 500–1,000 presses
